<b>Social Audit</b>	A process of appraising skills, facilities & in general the capacity of a given area usually supported by a questionnaire
<b>Social Economy</b>	That part of the economy operating between the market economy (private sector) & the non-market economy (public sector). The social economy operates where the market has failed to respond to the demands for provision of services & /or employment, e.g. childcare, care of the elderly, recycling. The social economy aims to resource the local community, ownership remains in the local community & there is local control of resources
<b>Social Exclusion</b>	Cumulative marginalisation from production (employment), from consumption (income poverty), from social networks (community, family & neighbours), from decision making & from adequate quality of life
<b>Social Partners</b>	Groups such as IFA, Macra na Feirme, ICMSA, ICTU, IBEC
<b>SPC</b>	Strategic Policy Committee, part of Local Government Reform
<b>State Agencies</b>	Department of Social, Community & Family Affairs, FAS, TEAGASC, etc
<b>Sub Committees</b>	Monitor the delivery of a strategy
<b>Task groups</b>	Deliver the model
<b>Technical Assistance</b>	Non financial assistance categorised for example by supporting a local development group through organising meetings, providing assistance in forming steering groups, back up support
